



# 012 Fruit Pair Game


Stimulate the memory locating and identifying fruit

# **Starting Session**

Print out the fruit sheet and follow the instructions for cutting out and preparation. Show the sheet and explain the differences between the fruits: colours, shapes, and the name of each one. Explain the rules for the Pair Game.

#### **Miniland Product Game**

Place the vegetable sheet in the Miniland Pair Game and start looking for pairs. In turns, open two pieces from the "memory". When you find a pair you say aloud: "it's a vegetable and it's called... (the name of the fruit)".



# **Digital Game**

When finished, play the digital game to reinforce content. The memory game consists of finding 8 pairs of fruits.
